HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1663, L.D. 1863, Bill, "AN ACT  
to Regulate Campaign Activities on Election Day."

Amend the bill in section 3, by striking out all  
of the 2nd paragraph which reads as follows:

"This subsection does not prohibit a person from passing out stickers  
at \_\_\_\_\_ the voting place which are to be pasted on the ballot at  
a primary election."
