HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1663, L.D. 1863, Bill,
"AN ACT to Regulate Campaign Activities on Election Day."

Amend the Bill in section 3 by striking out all of the
2nd paragraph of subsection 3 which read as follows:

"This subsection does not prohibit a person from passing out stickers
at the voting place which are to be pasted on the ballot at a
primary election."

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove superfluous language
as recommended by the Committee on Election Laws. This amendment
is presented on behalf of the Committee on Bills in the Second
Reader.
