HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1664, L.D. 1864, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Registration on Election Day."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"\$631." in subsection 3 by striking out all of the 1st
underlined sentence and inserting in its place the following:
'In any municipality, the registrar shall accept registrations,
during such hours as the municipal officers shall prescribe,
on the 9 business days next prior to election day.'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated
"\$632." by striking out all of subsection 2.

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated
"\$632." by striking out the first paragraph of subsection 3
and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Three business days prior to election. In any
municipality, the registrar shall accept registrations during
such hours as the municipal officers shall prescribe on the
3 business days next prior to election day.'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated
"\$632." by renumbering subsections 3 and 4 to be subsections
2 and 3.

Statement of Fact

This amendment permits registrations by justices of the
peace and notaries as well as in person during the 9 business

days prior to election day for a regular election and during the 3 business days next prior to election day for a special election and provides that all those registrations shall either be handled by special certificate or by a supplemental voting list.
