SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1669, L.D. 1867, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Lifeline Electrical Services."

Amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 3 of that part designated "§86." and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Reimbursement to utilities. The method, to include payment periods, by which electric utilities shall be reimbursed by the Public Utilities Commission, from funds appropriated from the General Fund, for lost revenues resulting from lifeline rates; and

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the source of the funds to be used by/Public Utilities Commission in reimbursing electric utilities for lost revenues resulting from lifeline rates.
