HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1681, L.D. 1875, Bill, "AN ACT Permitting the Director of Public Lands to Sell Small Parcels of Public Reserved Lands with Legislative Approval."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in the first paragraph after the amending clause by striking out the first 4 lines (3 lines in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

'1-A. Sale of small parcels. The director may, after review by the Joint Standing Committee on State Government and subsequent approval by the Governor, sell any parcel of public reserved land not exceeding 1/4 acre in size provided that:'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in the next to the last paragraph before the Statement of Fact by striking out the underlined words "The director" and inserting in their place the following: 'Prior to requesting review and approval, the director'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this Amendment is to change the method of approval for the sale of small parcels of public reserved land, by permitting the director of the Bureau of Public Lands to sell such parcels only after review by the State Government Committee and approval of the Governor.
