HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1689, L.D. 1877, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide for the Licensing of Denturists."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

'§1100-I. Denture repair

Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, dental
lab technicians shall be authorized to repair removable
prosthetic dentures without a written prescription from
a dentist whenever no impression of the human oral cavity
or vertical dimension or registration of vertical dimension
is involved.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment permits dental lab technicians to make
repair of removable prosthetic dentures without a prescription
from a dentist if no impression or registration of vertical
dimension is involved.
