HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1689, L.D. 1877, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Provide for the Licensing of Denturists."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated  
"§1100-E." by inserting after subsection 4 the following:

'5. Requirements for license. No person, after June 1, 1978, shall be licensed as a denturist unless the person is at least 18 years of age and is a resident of this State, and has fulfilled the following education requirements:

- A. Fifty hours of bacteriology;
- B. Fifty hours of anatomy;
- C. Fifty hours of inter-oral procedures; and
- D. Fifty hours of inter-oral practice.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment adds education requirements as a prerequisite to licensing denturists after June 1, 1978.
