SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1689, L. D. 1877, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide for the Licensing of Denturists."


Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated
"§1100-B." by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in
its place the following:

'2. Denturist. "Denturist" means a person licensed under
this subchapter to engage in the practice of denture technology
under the supervision of a dentist.'
