HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1734, L.D. 1887, Bill,
"AN ACT to Clarify Election Related Laws."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 15 and
inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 15. 21 MRSA §892, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Unauthorized activity. Within 250 feet of the voting
place, a person shall not solicit donations, gifts, contributions,
purchase of tickets or make similar demands or request or obtain
signatures on petitions without the express approval of the warden
or ward clerk. This subsection shall apply only in municipalities
in which the warden and ward clerk are elected officials according
to the municipal charter.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to provide that the
restriction on activity applies only when the warden and ward
clerk are elected officials.
