HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1741, L.D. 1889, Bill,
"AN ACT to Reform the Regulation of Watch, Guard and Patrol
Agencies and of Private Detectives."

Amend the Bill in section 3 in that part designated
"§6059." by adding at the end the following underlined
paragraph:

'Licensees may submit satisfactory evidence of sufficient
liability insurance to provide the same or more coverage
as the bonding requirements instead of giving the commissioner
a bond, if the licensee so desires.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment allows private investigators to provide
proof of adequate liability insurance in lieu of posting a bond.
