HOUSE AMENDMENT "L" to H.P. 1741, L.D. 1889, Bill, "AN ACT to Reform the Regulation of Watch, Guard and Patrol Agencies and of Private Detectives."

Amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all of that part designated "§3782." and inserting in its place the following:

## '§3782. Application

This chapter shall not apply to any of the following:

- 1. Certain law enforcement officers. Any person currently employed as a state, county or local law enforcement officer, or any constable, either full time or part time, provided a bond in the amount of \$10,000 is issued to the appointing authority of the officer or constable and provided the employment of the officer or constable as a security guard is on a part-time and off-duty basis; and
- 2. Proprietary security organizations. Any proprietary security organization.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment exempts from the application of the application of the bill:

 Any person employed as a state, county or local law enforcement officer or as a constable, if that person has a \$10,000 bond issued to his appointing authority and if he works on a part-time and off-duty basis; and 2. Any "proprietary security organization," a term defined in the bill.
