
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1741, L.D. 1889, Bill, "AN ACT to Reform the Regulation of Watch, Guard and Patrol Agencies and of Private Detectives."

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$3780." subsection 1, paragraph G, 3rd line (same in L.D.) by striking out the following underlined words: "therefore regularly"

Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "\$6063." subsection 1, paragraph G, 3rd line (same in L.D.) by striking out the following underlined words: "theretofore regularly"

Statement of Fact

This amendment allows for the provision of armed guards where necessary in a strike situation for the protection of payroll, property or premises.
