HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 588, L.D. 1895, Bill, "AN ACT Making Additional Appropriations for the Expenditures of State Government, to Make Allocations from the Highway Fund, Title II of the Public Works Act, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1978 and June 30, 1979."
