SENATE AMENDMENT "E " to S.P. 588, L.D. 1895, Bill, "AN ACT Making Additional Appropriations for the Expenditures of State Government, to Make Allocations from the Highway Fund, Title II of the Public Works Act, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1978 and June 30, 1979."

Amend the Bill in SECTION E by striking out all of the 5th line of subsection 5 of section 5 and inserting in its place the following:

'Prosecutorial District 2 \$82,000'

Further amend the Bill in SECTION E by striking out all of section 7 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 7. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of the Attorney General the sum of \$302,375 for the payment of salaries of assistant district attorneys. The breakdown shall be as follows:

ATTORNEY GENERAL, DEPARTMENT OF		
Personal Services	\$137,875	\$164,500

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Act, this section shall not become effective until October 1, 1977.'

Further amend the Bill by adjusting all totals to reflect any changes made by this amendment.

Statement of Fact

This amendment increases the appropriation for assistant district attorneys in order to provide an additional \$14,500 for compensation of assistant district attorneys' salaries in Prosecutorial District 2. This increase is necessary to make up for federal funding of assistant district attorneys' salaries which will be lost in August 1977.
