'Sec. 150+A. Office of sheriff; purchase of uniforms. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, any person who has been elected to the office of sheriff may, prior to taking office, purchase uniforms for all fulltime deputy sheriffs and charges for the same shall be paid from sums set aside in the sheriff's or support of prisoners accounts and designated for the purchase of uniforms, if sufficient
