HOUSE AMENDMENT to S.P. 590, L.D. 1896, Bill, "AN  
ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies  
in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 50 the following:

'Sec. 50-A. 12 MRSA §303, first sentence, as enacted by  
PL 1975, c. 542, is amended to read:

Any person, other than State and Federal Governments,  
owning or operating any dam not licensed by or under the  
jurisdiction of the Federal Power Commission, shall annually  
register with the commission, on forms provided by the commission,  
on or before the first day of January of each calendar year.'

Fiscal Note

It is estimated that enactment of this amendment would  
cost about \$10 per dam and that there are about 106 dams  
affected by this amendment.

Statement of Fact

This amendment eliminates duplicate registration of dams  
with both state and federal authorities, providing for state  
registration only when there is no federal registration.
