HOUSE AMENDMENT ^{DD} to S. P. 590, L.D. 1896, Bill,
"AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies
in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 13 the following:

'Sec. 13-A. 5 MRSA §8-B, last sentence, as amended by
PL 1977, c. 78, §3-A, is repealed and the following enacted
in its place:

No charge shall be made for the provision of housing facilities
when the state employee involved is required as a condition
of his employment to reside in such housing facilities.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that no charge shall be made for
provision of housing authorities when the employee is required
to live in the housing facility as a condition of his employment.
It deletes the provision that above a certain salary level, such a
state employee/^{is}charged for his housing.
