HOUSE AMENDMENT "N" to S.P. 590, L.D. 1896, Bill,
"AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and
Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 31 the
following:

'Sec. 31-A. 5 MRSA §1121, sub-§2, ¶E, is amended
by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

Any retired person may elect to receive, or not receive,
any portion of a retirement allowance by notifying the
executive director, in writing, of that amount of the
retirement allowance the retired person does not wish
to receive. Waiver of retirement benefits under this
section will in no way effect benefits payable to a
beneficiary under such option elected by the retired
person at point of retirement.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides additional flexibility within the
State Retirement System and has been approved by the Retirement
System.
