HOUSE AMENDMENT"O" to S.P. 590, L.D. 1896, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the bill by inserting after section 73 the following:

'Sec. 73-A. 14 MRSA §8102, ~~sub-§3-A~~, is enacted to read:

3-A. Property damage. As used in section 8103, subsection 3, the term "property damage" shall include property loss.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment insures that the \$10,000 limit on liability in the Maine Tort Claims Act applies to acts or omissions causing property loss as well as property damage.
