HOUSE AMENDMENT "X " to S.P. 590, L.D. 1896, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 48 the following: 'Sec. 48-A. 10 MRSA §702, last sentence, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 633, §21, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

The Maine Guarantee Authority is created to encourage the making of mortgage loans by using economic factors to determine the probability of the enterprises achieving the purpose of furthering expansion of such enterprises in the State.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the Maine Guarantee Authority, as set forth in Title 10, section 702, is to insure the preservation and betterment of the economy of the State and its inhabitants. The purpose of this proposed language change is to clarify the factors that are to be used in determining the advisability of making a loan to a particular enterprise. This change is needed to insure that, despite the numerous amendments that have been made to this section, economic factors are determinative in the decision of whether or not to make a loan to a particular enterprise.
