HOUSE AMENDMENT "Z" to S.P. 590, L.D. 1896, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and  
Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 11 the  
following:

'Sec. 11-A. 3 MRSA §551, 1st sentence, as enacted  
by PL 1977, c. 367, is amended to read:

The Commissioner of Finance and Administration, together  
with the Treasurer of State, shall advise the Legislature and  
the Governor in a timely manner and in written form as to the  
effect on the state's bonded debt of any bond issue or  
issues proposed ~~which would not be self-liquidating~~.

Sec. 11-B. Effective date. Section 11-A will take  
effect 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the phrase  
"which would not be self-liquidating" which inadvertently  
limits the analysis beyond what the Legislature intended.
