SENATE AMENDMENT"H"to S.P. 590, L.D. 1896, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the bill by inserting after section 115 the following:

'Sec. 115-A. 30 MRSA §2453, last sentence, as last amended
by PL 1971, c. 593, §22, is repealed and the following enacted in
its place:

The municipal officers or county commissioners as provided for in section 2452 shall give written notice of the application to the Department of Transportation by sending, by ordinary mail, a copy of the application not less than 7 and not more than 14 days prior to the hearing.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deals with permits to establish or operate automobile graveyards or junkyards. It deletes the requirement that the municipal officers or the county commissioners send notice of the hearing to the Department of Transportation by registered mail.

Registered mail is expensive and is not necessary for providing notice to a state agency.

The amendment also corrects the wording of the statute.
