SENATE AMENDMENT "I" to S.P. 590, L.D. 1896, Bill,
"AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and
Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 84 the
following:

'Sec. 84-A. 17 MRSA §332, sub-§4, last sentence,
as enacted by PL 1977, c. 350, §4, is repealed and the
following enacted in its place:

No licensee shall operate any gambling machine involving
a service agreement in more than one location at the
same time.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment prohibits the operation by any one
licensee of gambling machines involving a service agreement
in more than one location at the same time.
