HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 618, L.D. 1906, Bill, "AN ACT to increase the Limits of Authorized Indebtedness of the Brunswick Sewer District."

Amend the bill by inserting \longleftrightarrow before the enacting clause the following:

Emergency preamble.

'Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it is the purpose of this Act to increase the authorized indebtedness of the Brunswick Sewer District by \$1,500,000; and

Whereas, in order to properly carry out the statutory duties imposed on it by charter, it is vital that the authorized indebtedness of the Brunswick Sewer District be increased as soon as possible to \$3,500,000; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill.
