STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-EIGHT

AN ACT to Establish a Retirement Income Tax Credit that is Equal to 20% of the Federal Credit.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 5130 is enacted to read:

§ 5130. Retirement credit

Each year a resident may receive a credit against state taxes due equal to 20% of any credit he received that same year under the Internal Revenue Code, section 37, credit for the elderly.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to establish a retirement income tax credit that is equal to 20% of the federal credit.
