COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1876, L.D. 1912, RESOLVE,
to Appeal the Decision of State Claims Board Regarding Property

Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title
and inserting in its place the following:

'Claims appeal to the Legislature. Resolved: That the
decision of the State Claims Board be appealed to the Legislature
pursuant to the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1510, subsection
1; and be it further

Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund
the sum of \$4,132.84 to reimburse the following persons in the
amounts indicated as a full and final settlement of their claims
for property damage against the State due to the collapse of a
building at Northern Maine Vocational-Technical Institute:
