HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1868, L.D. 1918, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Type of Notice under the Exceptional Children Statutes."

Amend the bill in the last line before the statement of fact by inserting after the punctuation the following:

'Whenever the administrative unit has reasonable cause to believe that the notice was not received by the interested parent, surrogate parent or guardian, the administrative unit shall then give notice by certified mail or registered letter.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide an alternative method of notice under the Exceptional Child Act.
