COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1860, L.D. 1923, Bill,
"AN ACT to Restore Matching Funds to the Maine Criminal Justice
Planning and Assistance Agency."

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause the
following:

'Sec. 1. Governor's recommendations. The Governor shall
annually, prior to January 15th, submit to the Legislature for
approval his recommendations of Maine Criminal Justice Planning
and Assistance Agency's proposals for funding personnel and
program costs in State Government agencies for each fiscal year.
These recommendations shall be submitted through the Joint Stand-
ing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs and no
expenditures under such proposals shall be made until approved
by the Legislature. Recommendations shall include such informa-
tion as expected length of funding of such programs and restric-
tions or limitations placed on the grant.

The effective date of this section shall be January 1, 1979.'

Further amend the bill in the first paragraph after the
enacting clause by inserting before the underlined word "Appro-
priation " the following: 'Sec. 2.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will require ~~L~~egislative approval of all proposed expenditures affecting ~~S~~tate ~~G~~overnment agencies by the Maine Criminal Justice Planning and Assistance Agency.
