SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1860, L.D. 1923, Bill, "AN ACT to Restore Matching Funds to the Maine Criminal Justice Planning and Assistance Agency."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Restore Matching Funds to the Maine Criminal
Justice Planning and Assistance Agency and to Provide
Funds for the Administration of the Uniform Crime Reporting
Program within the Bureau of State Police.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the first paragraph after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

Sec. 2. Appropriation. Funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund as follows to carry out the purposes of this Act:

1978-79 PUBLIC SAFETY, DEPARTMENT OF Bureau of State Police Bureau of Identification \$48,309 (3) Personal Services 39,210 All Other 4,500 Capital Expenditures \$92,019 Total

Provides funds for Uniform Crime reporting program.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide funds for the continued operation of the uniform crime reporting program within the State Police's Bureau of Identification which was enacted by Public Law 1973, chapter 707 and funded by the Criminal Justice Planning and Assistance Agency.
