HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1857, L.D. 1924, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Brake Requirements on Agricultural Vehicles."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of that part designated "(6)" and inserting in its place the following:

'(6) A dolly axle, so-called, on a farm truck transporting agricultural products and supplies on public ways while engaged in agricultural activities, providing such an axle shall not be considered in determining the legal gross weight or axle limits permitted on the vehicle. A 2-axle farm truck equipped with such an axle shall, for all weight proposed, be considered a 2-axle vehicle.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment allows farmers to utilize dolly wheels in all aspects of planting and harvesting in order to stabilize loads. It has no effect on the laws relating to weight.
