HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1857, L.D. 1924, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Brake Requirements on Agricultural Vehicles."

Amend the bill by striking out all of subparagraph (6) and inserting in its place the following:

'(6) A dolly axle, so-called, on a farm truck transporting freshly harvested agricultural products from the growing areas to processing plants or storage areas, providing such an axle shall not be considered in determining the legal gross weight or axle limits permitted on the vehicle. A 2-axle farm truck equipped with such an axle shall, for all weight proposed, be considered a 2-axle vehicle.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment is recommended by the Committee on Bills in the Second Reading and offered in place of the committee amendment. It makes no substantive change in the legislation involved but corrects a mechanical defect of repeated wording.
