SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.  
1858, L.D. 1925, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Persons Other than  
Arborists to Take Down Trees by Topping or Sections."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last  
underlined sentence before the statement of fact and inserting  
in its place the following:

'A. "Arborist" shall not mean a person who, for compensation  
of \$250 or less during any 12 consecutive calendar months,  
takes down or fells the trees by topping or by sections.  
A municipality may, by ordinance:

- (1) Limit or prohibit any person exempted from the  
definition of arborist by this paragraph from advertising  
or soliciting use of his services for taking down or  
felling trees by topping or by sections; and
- (2) Require that, if any person exempted from the  
definition of arborist by this paragraph takes down or  
fells trees by topping or by sections, he inform  
the owner of the property on which the trees are to  
be topped or sectioned of whether or not he has  
insurance against liability resulting from any  
damage caused by or arising out of the topping  
or sectioning of the trees, and of the type and  
extent of the insurance coverage.'

Statement of Fact


This amendment permits municipal ordinances which:

- 1. Limit or prohibit advertising or solicitation by a person exempted from the definition of arborist; and
- 2. Require that exempted person to disclose his liability insurance coverage or lack of that coverage, for damage resulting from topping or sectioning trees.
