COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1879, L.D. 1933, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Establish the Maine-Canadian Legislative Advisory  
Commission."

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated  
"§224" by adding at the end the following new sentences:

'The director shall be able to speak the french language  
fluently. He shall report to and be subject to the direction  
of the Legislative Council.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all  
of that part designated "§226." and inserting in its place the  
following:

'§226. Funds

Funds from the Federal Government, state appropriation,  
or from any individual, group, foundation, corporation or other  
private source may be accepted by the Maine-Canadian Legislative  
Advisory Office and expended for purposes consistent with this  
chapter.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the  
following:

'Sec. 3. PL 1977, c. 579, SECTION J, Sec. 4, is repealed  
and the following enacted in its place:

Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act:

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to require that the director be able to speak French fluently and to provide that he shall report to and be subject to the direction of the Legislative Council.

PL 1977, c. 579 appropriated \$24,286 to fund the Maine-Canadian Exchange Advisory Commission and Office. This amendment makes these funds available for this bill.
