HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1886, L.D. 1943, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Grant to the Supreme Judicial Court the Power to Remove a Judicial Officer from Office.

Amend the Resolution by striking out in the last line of the 5th paragraph the underlined words "or by rule of court" and inserting in their place the underlined words 'or in the absence of statute by rule of court'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make clear the fact that statutory provisions on terms for removal of judicial officers shall have precedence over rules of court on those terms.
