Amend the Amendment by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

29 MRSA §2362, sub-§11 is enacted to read:

ll. Special mobile equipment. Special mobile equipment
as defined in section 1, subsection 14.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this Amendment is to correct an error in the committee amendment. The committee amendment refers to a different category of equipment known as special equipment. The intent is to exempt special mobile equipment from the title law and to make the definition of special mobile equipment consistent with the definition in Title 29, section 1, subsection 14.
