
SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1907,

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete the requirement in
the committee amendment that the State Board of Nursing,^{State Board of Pharmacy} and the
Board of Registration in Medicine submit their budgets to the
Department of Human Services. Since the department is a payor
of fees to nurses and doctors, those providers' respective licensing
boards should be autonomous and not subject to review by the
department.
