HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
1914, L.D. 1975, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Substitution of
Generic Drugs by Pharmacists."

Amend the amendment in the 2nd paragraph after the amend-
ing clause by striking out the 13th and 14th lines

and inserting in their place the following:

'prescription, unless the physician, osteopath or dentist
directs him not to substitute a generic or chemically equivalent'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the generic substitution law by
making substitution of generic drugs by oral prescription con-
sistent with written prescriptions.
