COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1916, L.D. 1977, Bill, "AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Construct an Access Road to the Phase 2 Housing Project on the Penobscot Tribal Reservation."

Amend the bill by striking out everything in the title and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT Allocating Funds to Construct an Access Road to the Phase 2 Housing Project on the Penobscot Tribal Reservation'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Allocation of funds for the construction of a state highway in the Indian Reservation of Indian Island. The following funds shall be allocated from the General Highway Surplus Fund to the Department of Transportation, Bureau of Highways:

Bureau of Highways

Allocation

All Other

\$30,000

These funds shall be used to construct an access road to the housing project designated ME 12-3, "Phase 2 Housing Project," located on the Penobscot tribal reservation. Any balance on June 30, 1979, shall carry forward until the purpose for which the allocation is made shall be accomplished.

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to allocate funds from the General Highway Surplus Fund for the construction of an access road to the Phase 2 Housing Project on the Penobscot Tribal Indian Reservation. Without this amendment, the allocation would be derived from the General Fund.
