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**AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Construct an Access Road to the Phase 2 Housing Project  
on the Penobscot Tribal Reservation.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Appropriation; Penobscot Tribal Reservation Housing Authority.** The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act:

**PENOBSCOT TRIBAL RESERVATION HOUSING  
AUTHORITY**

All other

**\$30,000**

These funds shall be used to construct an access road to the housing project designated ME 12-3, "Phase 2 Housing Project," located on the Penobscot Tribal Reservation. Any balance remaining in this account on June 30, 1979 shall not lapse but shall be carried forward from year to year to be expended for the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill appropriates funds to construct an access road to the federally constructed housing project "ME 12-3" located on the Penobscot Tribal Reservation. While federal moneys will fund the cost of the project, the Federal Government requires construction of an access road which cannot be paid for by federal funds. This bill will provide that access road and ensure the completion of the housing project.
