## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 108TH LEGISLATURE SECOND REGULAR SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1919, L.D. 1980, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the University of Maine Labor Relations Act."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

- '26 MRSA \$1024, sub-\$1-B, ¶¶'s A, B and C, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 581, \$5, are amended to read:
  - A. Faculty and instructors; and
  - B. Administrative staff;-and.
  - E:--Classified-employees-'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate the classified bargaining unit set up for vocational-technical institute employees in amendments to the University of Maine Collective Bargaining Law during last session. The faculty and instructors of the vocational-technical institutes and the schools for practical nursing have been

included in the faculty and instructors' unit created by that legislation. In addition, a unit determination hearing is currently underway for the administrative staff bargaining unit.
