## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 108TH LEGISLATURE SECOND REGULAR SESSION

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1921, L.D. 1982, Bill, "AN ACT Clarifying the Statutes Relating to Municipalities."

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end, before the statement of fact, the following:

'Sec. 12. Validation. Any vote taken at a 1978 annual town meeting, pursuant to the procedures of Title 28, section 101, first paragraph, as amended by Public Law 1977, chapter 496, section 39, shall be deemed valid for the purpose of Title 28, section 101.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment makes clear that any vote taken at a 1978 annual town meeting pursuant to the procedures of Title 28, section 101, first paragraph, as amended by public Xaw, 1977, chapter 496, section 39, shall be deemed a valid local option vote. This provision thus resolves the possible question of validity of these votes which was raised by the enactment of public Xaw 1977, chapter 292 and chapter 496, each of which provided for different election times for local option questions.
