
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
1925, L.D. 1986, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Law Concerning the
Posting of Bonds by Electric Companies with the Department
of Environmental Protection for Certain Licenses or Permits."

Amend the Amendment by striking out the period at the
end of the last paragraph before the statement of fact
and inserting in its place the following:

' or in lieu of that bond, satisfactory evidence of
financial capacity to make that reimbursement.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment permits substitution for a surety bond of
evidence of financial capacity to make reimbursement. The
cost of surety bonds to electric utilities would be an
unnecessary expense if the utility has sufficient assets to
assure the department/^{of} reimbursement.
