Amend the resolve in the 4th and 5th lines (2nd and 3rd in

Further amend the resolve in the 5th line (3rd in L.D.) by
inserting after the word "shall" the following: ', for fair market
value as determined by the Bureau of Public Improvements, '

be at fair market value as determined by the Bureau of Public
Improvements.
