Amend the resolve in the 4th and 5th lines (2nd and 3rd in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", in consideration of \$1,500 paid by Allan L. Robbins and Verla W. Robbins,"

Further amend the resolve in the 5th line (3rd in L.D.) by inserting after the word "shall" the following: ', for fair market value as determined by the Bureau of Public Improvements,'
