SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to  
S.P. 630, L.D. 1989, Bill, "AN ACT to Ensure the Safety of  
Minors Taking Canoe Trips while Attending Summer Camp."

Amend the Amendment in section 2 in that part designated  
"§2054." in the 2nd paragraph by striking out in the 3rd line  
the underlined word and figures "June 1, 1979" and inserting  
in their place the underlined word and figures 'January 1, 1979'

Further amend the Amendment in section 2 in that part  
designated "§2054." in the 4th paragraph by inserting after the  
first sentence the following: 'The commissioner may require  
documentation of that experience and training when he determines  
that documentation to be necessary.'

Further amend the Amendment in section 2 in that part  
designated "§2054." in the last paragraph by striking out in the  
2nd line the underlined word and figures "June 1, 1979" and  
inserting in their place the underlined word and figures  
'January 1, 1979' .

Statement of Fact

This amendment would change the effective date of the committee  
amendment from June 1, 1979 to January 1, 1979 in order to enable  
trip leaders to apply for permits under the new procedure in

time to have the permits granted before the summer of 1979.

In addition, this amendment gives the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife the authority to require documentation of experience and training under the special application process.
