HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1930, L.D. 2003, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow the Town of Otisfield to Meet its Obligations to Cumberland County for Existing Bonded Indebtedness Through a Lump Sum Payment."

Amend the Bill by striking out the figure "\$20,000" in the next to the last line before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the figure '\$22,940'

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the figure \$20,000 to \$22,940 which reflects the amount of principal bonded indebtedness based on valuations for 1978 from January 1, 1978 to July 1, 1978.
