COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1934, L.D. 2005, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide Funding for Programs to Aid School Administrative
Units to Identify and Provide Special Educational Programs
for Gifted and Talented Children."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated
"§3304." by adding at the end of the first paragraph the
following underlined sentence:

'Any grant shall be made on the basis of \$1 of state matching
funds for each \$2 of funds appropriated by a school administrative
unit.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require that grants
made under this chapter shall be made in a matching basis of
\$1 of state funds for each \$2 of locally appropriated money.
