COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1934, L.D. 2005, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide Funding for Programs to Aid School Administrative
Units to Identify and Provide Special Educational Programs
for Gifted and Talented Children."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated "§3304." by adding at the end of the first paragraph the following underlined sentence:

'Any grant shall be made on the basis of \$1 of state matching funds for each \$2 of funds appropriated by a school administrative unit.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require that grants made under this chapter shall be made in a matching basis of \$1 of state funds for each \$2 of locally appropriated money.
