Amend the Amendment on page 10 in the 9th line from the  
end by striking out the underlined figure "8" and inserting in  
its place the underlined figure '9'

Further amend the Amendment on page 11 in the 7th line  
by striking out the underlined words "public employees"  
and inserting in their place the underlined word 'qualified'

The purpose of this amendment is to provide reimbursement  
for diagnostic psychological services. It also provides that  
the commissioners may, by rules and regulations insure that  
reimbursable services for students attending nonpublic schools  
are performed by qualified persons.
