Further amend the amendment on page 11 in the 3rd line, by
striking out the figure "8" and inserting in its place the
following: '9'

Further amend the amendment on page 11 in the 7th line by
striking out the underlined words "public employees" and inserting
in their place the underlined word 'qualified'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide reimbursement
for diagnostic psychological services. It also provides that the
commissioners may, by rules and regulations insure that reimburs-
able services for students attending nonpublic schools are performed
by qualified persons.
